



2020 Scholarship Application Form

Colorado Association of Wheat Growers

Two \$1,000 college scholarships will be awarded by Colorado Association of Wheat Growers (CAWG).

One scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who plans to attend an accredited college, university, junior college or community college. The student must enter college the same year as their graduation from high school.

The second scholarship is the Larry K. Haynes CAWG Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship will be awarded to a college sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student who is attending an accredited college, university, junior college or community college. Students intending to major in agriculture-related fields are strongly urged to apply. The scholarships will be one-year, non-renewable awards.

The students must be classified as full time students and confirmation of enrollment by the college or university is required. This award may be given in addition to other grants and scholarships. The recipients will be chosen by a review panel.

Eligibility and Application Requirements

- Applicant's parent, grandparent, or legal guardian must be current or new members of CAWG **OR** the applicant must be nominated by a current or new member of CAWG. CAWG members who sponsor a student may each nominate one student.
- One letter of recommendation from a counselor, teacher, or employer.
- A transcript must accompany the application.
- The applicant must fill out and return the CAWG scholarship form no later than **March 27, 2020**.
- As part of the application, students are required to compose and submit two essays, the topics are listed below. The essay should be no more than one page typed with a font size no smaller than 12 point, and double spaced on 8½ x 11 paper. Include your name and the essay topic on each page. The scholarship winner's essays may be published in future CAWG publications.
